ORDER

Sub: Appointment of "Returning Officer" and the "Election Programme" for Conduct of Election of Ramraja Multi State Agro Cooperative Society Ltd., Jhansi, Uttar Pradesh - reg.

1. The Cooperative Election Authority has been established under Section 45 of the MSCS Act, 2002 (as amended in 2023). As per Section 45-I of the said Act, the Authority discharges the following functions: -
 - i. Conduct of elections of the multi-state cooperative society;
 - ii. Supervise, direct and control the matters relating to preparation of electoral rolls; and
 - iii. Such other functions as may be prescribed.
2. Accordingly, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 45 K (1) of the Multi-State Co-operative Societies (MSCS) Act 2002, as amended by the MSCS amendment Act 2023 read with Rule 19F (a) of the MSCS Rules 2002, as amended with MSCS Rules in 2023, the Co-operative Election Authority hereby appoints District Magistrate/Collector, Jhansi as Returning Officer for conducting Elections of the society as per details given in subsequent paras.
3. The detailed election programme is as under :-

circulated in the area of operation as required under Rule 19-I(3) and to publish election programme on the website of the society.

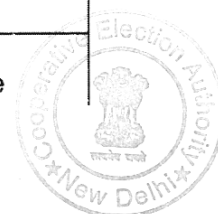
An Electoral Roll may be prepared containing the particulars as required under Rule 19-I, i.e., (i) Admission Number (ii) Name of the Member (iii) Name of the father or husband and (iv) Address.

In addition, the Electoral Roll prepared should include the requirements of Bye-Law 15 of the Society to determine whether the member is disqualified or eligible to vote. The Bye-Law envisage minimum transaction of Rs.10,000/- in two consecutive years and disqualification on account of non-attendance of member in 3 consecutive General Meeting during the period of preceeding 5 years from the due date of constitution of Board unless it was condoned.

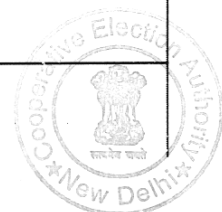
Finally the last column would indicate whether the Member is eligible to cast vote or contest election as on 30.06.2026. For the purpose of contesting election, the relevant By-laws may be taken into account including whether the Director has not absented from three continuous Board Meetings as required under Section 43 (m) of MSCS Act.

5. RO is requested to ensure the election is conducted as per the MSCS Act, 2002 as amended by MSCS (Amendment) Act 2023 and Rules framed thereunder. In case any provision of Bye-Laws of the Society is inconsistent with the provision of Act and Rules made thereunder, then provisions of the Act/Rules shall prevail over such inconsistent provisions of the Bye-Laws and decision taken by CEA in this regard shall be final.

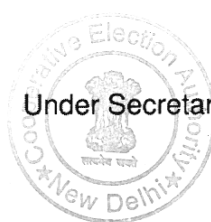
6. RO may submit proposal for appointment of adequate number of ARO

7. The Constituency shall be as per registered and approved Bye-Laws of the Society. Contestant would be forming respective constituency. Every voter member has a right to elect all the directors individually.

8. RO is advised to go through the documents meant for conduct of election- namely preparation of member list, preparation of voter list and information relating to seeking prior approval of Board of Directors and Office Bearers. These documents are available on the website <https://cres.gov.in> under the heading "Cooperative Election Authority" (Handbooks of Returning Officer). Instructions contained in these documents must be followed in letter and spirit so as to ensure free and fair election.
